The Urban Management Centre (UMC), ATI organized the **9th part** of the webinar series on **“Provisions of Employees Provident Fund (EPF)” on 29th September 2020**, Tuesday from 3.00 pm to 4.30 pm, for the functionaries of ULBs of West Bengal.

The Urban Local Bodies in India employ a sizeable number of contractual and casual employees who had been brought under the ambit of the Employees’ Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 by the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India. This part of the webinar series focused on EPF portal management and hence highlighted some tasks that municipal functionaries commonly faced problems on. Some of the topics of discussion were as follows:

- Use and features of Umang app – official mobile app of EPFO
- Brief of EPF 1952 Act., EPF Scheme 1995, FPS Scheme 1971, and EDLI Scheme 1976
- Submission of offline claims like death case, transfer claim and all types of online claim submission
- Composite Claim Form (CCF) submission procedure

There was active participation of 43 participants from 30 ULBs of West Bengal, which comprised of functionaries from accounts and finance departments of ULBs of West Bengal. Some ULBs also participated in a blended format with multiple participants. The overall session after the presentation was quite interactive.

Shri Sanjib Kr. Halder from EPFO, Regional Office, Shillong conducted the session and Shri Kaushik Ghosh, Assistant Professor, Urban Management Centre, ATI moderated the session.
